### **Off Duty Officer Safety and Well-Being, Search Techniques and Contraband Control for Corrections Officers IN-SERVICE TRAINING**

**(These courses can be applied toward the annual 20 hours In-Service Training requirement)**

#### **COURSE DESCRIPTION:**

**Search Techniques and Contraband Control-** This training will discuss various types of searches and types of contraband their importance of within a correctional facility. Participants will discuss and review types of searches, reasons for searches, purpose of searches, legal considerations associated with searches, concerns of contraband and various types encountered in correctional facilities. (4 hours)

**Off Duty Officer Safety and Well-Being -** This training will discuss why Officers should always be prepared for situations that may happen off-duty. This training will also focus on all aspects of an officer's mental health and wellness, both on and off the job. (4 hours)

#### **TOPICS COVERED:**

- Legal Considerations of pat down searches.
- When to pat down: New arrests, inmate movement, suspicious activity, random vs. routine.
- When to Strip Search and Legal Considerations of a Strip Search.
- Legal Considerations of Property Searches
- Helping your family understand how dangerous your job is and that it can follow you home.
- To explain the importance of having a plan in place in case you encounter a violent offender off duty.
- Understanding physiological response to a perceived harmful event or attack
