Description: This two-day training course is designed to provide simple and effective tactics

and planning for Corrections Officers to remove and secure uncooperative, violent, or potentially violent inmates from a cell, reducing potential of injuries to

staff or inmates. The course focuses on verbal de-escalation strategies, team

control tactics and scenario-based role play exercises.

Training Objectives: Upon course completion, the attendee will be able to:

• Understand the stages and goals of Cell Extraction.

• Demonstrate situational planning and establishing team roles.

• Demonstrate verbal de-escalation prior to cell entry.

• Demonstrate appropriate tactical use of tools during cell entry.

• Demonstrate safe cell entry, subject control and handcuffing.
