CTO PROGRAM: The **Corrections Training and Evaluating Program** is an extension of the **corrections** selection process. It combines pre-field training with objective evaluations to ensure that the standards of a competent corrections officer are met. This is a 40 – hour course designed for experienced **corrections officers** to learn the "new job/task" of becoming a **Corrections Training Officer** – **CTO**. *The program will emphasize the CTO's role in Coaching, training, and objectively evaluating the recruit officer as they "earn" the right to wear your department's uniform.* Each student will receive a Corrections Training and Evaluation manual for this course.
